

Terms and Conditions for ICONS2010 Awards.

Anybody may nominate a maximum of two people to receive ICONS2010 awards. To do so, please send a profile of the nominee(s) to the Executive Secretary at i.akintunde@xnfoundation.org

Nominations should reach the Executive Secretary before Friday 2 April, 2010. The nominee should be a student, a high achiever, either in academics or in extra curricular activities. He/She should be someone who can inspire Nigerian students.

Once you are nominated, you agree to the following terms and conditions. If you have any questions, please contact the Executive Secretary.

- 1) Nomination is no guarantee that you will receive an ICONS2010 Award.
- 2) There is no upper or lower limit to the number of people who may receive the ICONS2010 Award.
- 3) The award winners will be announced at the dinner on 17 April, 2010 at the University of Kent, Canterbury.
- 4) XN Foundation has the right to withdraw the award at any time after you have been given, if you are found to have engaged in a disreputable act, such as if you have been convicted of a criminal offence, provided you are given reasonable opportunity to state your case to the Foundation.
- 5) The decision to give or withdraw an award is final.
- 6) If you have been given an award, you are entitled to style yourself a winner of the ICONS2010 award. This entitlement is permanent, unless the award has been withdrawn.
- 7) XN Foundation is entitled to use your name, photo or award for reasonable publicity, including publication on its website, or in newspapers or other public media.
